Hello Recreational Dance Families.

This will contain all of the information regarding the spring dance recital, participation and registration.

### Where and when is the Recital being held?

The recital this year will be held at Sauk Rapids Middle School CAC on May 17th at 1:00pm and 5:00pm 901 1st St S, Sauk Rapids, MN 56379

## Which show is my dancer in?

The first show at 1:00pm will include all of our Recreational, pre Company and Company dancers as well as a buddy dance. The second show at 5:00pm will include our pre Company and Company dancers as well as the buddy dance. Both shows will include our senior solos, however only the second show will include their senior slideshows.

## When do tickets go on sale and where will they be sold?

Tickets will go on sale on April 14th at the North Crest front desk. Tickets will be \$15-\$18. We can accept cash, check or cc. Tickets will be available at the door only if available. We will only accept cash or checks at the door. We recommend purchasing early to ensure that you have your preferred seating and get tickets together.

### When and how do I register? What about their costume, finale shirt, show video and show photos?

Performance packages are included with this letter and are due by February 21st. This package includes your dancer's costume, tights, finale shirt, show video and live action show photos. If you do not turn this package in, your dancer will not be able to participate in the spring recital or picture day.

#### What is the time commitment to do the show?

We ask that your dancer is able to attend our recital rehearsal on May 16th. Rehearsal times and specifics are included on the paper attached. This is the only extra time commitment for the recital. If you cannot attend the rehearsal and would still like to participate please note that it is possible, however you dancer will have not seen the space prior to being on stage and this can be the largest hindrance in having a confident performance!

#### **How do I register for the Buddy Dance?**

More information will be available soon regarding registration and practices. Please keep your eye on handouts and emails.

#### What shoes does my child need for the Spring Show?

We ask that all dancers have the appropriate shoes for both recitals. Ballet and Tap dancers need ballet shoes (Pink for girls and black for boys) and black tap shoes. Jazz and Hip Hop dancers need black jazz shoes and neutral hip hop shoes. All shoes can be sized and purchased at our front desk at reasonable prices or you can purchase from places such as Target, Walmart, Once Upon a Child, Facebook Marketplace and Amazon.

### When is picture week?

Dance picture week is April 16th & 17th in Studio B. We WILL NOT be having dance classes this week. Pictures will take place at the beginning of your child's scheduled class time. A group photo will be taken with all dancers in their show costumes and then each dancer will have 3 individual pictures taken. You will receive an email with a link to photo proofs to choose if and what you would like to purchase.
